We continue the previously started traditions, like, on the Saturday before the first Advent, we bring light to the village (children and adults walk through the village with candles stopping at 9 stations). Also, on Christmas, children distribute Christmas cards on the street telling about the birth of Jesus Christ.

On December 18, 2016, our Russian speaking congregation celebrated 20 year Anniversary of our existence in Liepa, with God's help. Special gratitude from our congregation is owed to pastor Andris Vainovskis and his Riga Second UMC for his support on this special occasion. Also, we are thankful to pastor Kristine and her husband, and the Cēsis UMC, pastor Vivita and her husband for attending with their little kids to support us. We are grateful to Hope Center girls for their help and presence. May God bless everyone.
